3. The date for the Annual Meeting has been changed to Tuesday, May 21. A letter with more details will be sent to Ohev members 30 days prior to the meeting.

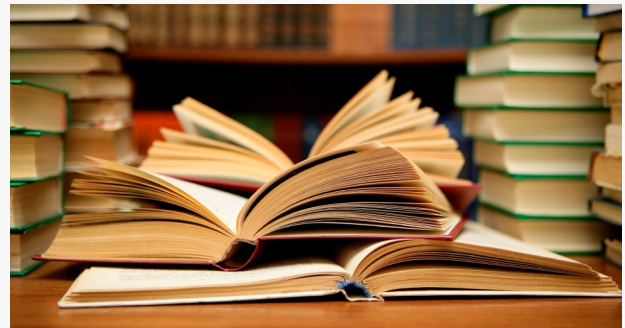
