For six weeks (June 22 – July 27) for half an hour
before the start of Shabbat Shacharit, a group will
sit together to reflect on the Ashrei and the five Hal-
luluyas we say every morning in Pesukei d’Zimra.
We will take one psalm each week and concentrate
on particular words and phrases, and then share our
thoughts.

The sessions will be led by Dr. Ben Elton and will
meet from 8:45 AM – 9:15 AM in the shul library.
The sessions are free of charge and everyone is wel-
come. All you need is a willingness to think and
share.
