This week's kiddush is sponsored by the Messinger Family in celebration of Lylah's Bat Mitzvah. Mazal Tov, Lylah!

OSTNS is delighted to be celebrating Lylah's Bat Mitzvah. The format and location of our Shacharit services will be a bit different than usual:

At 7:30 AM, Mashkemin service will be held in the chapel, open to men and women, but please note that all men who would like to fully attend Lylah's Bat Mitzvah service should first attend mashkemin.

At 9:15 AM, we will have two Shacharit services:

- Regular Shabbat morning service in the chapel for Pesukei d'Zimra, Shacharit, Torah reading, and Haftarah.
- Lylah's bat mitzvah service (a women's tefilah service) in the sanctuary. Everyone is invited to attend. Men who want to attend this service are encouraged to daven in the mashkemin service. This service will include the women's tefilah Pesukei d'Zimra, Shacharit, Torah reading, and Haftarah.

Upon the conclusion of the Haftarah in both services, the group from the chapel will join the bat mitzvah service in the sanctuary for mussaf led by Jonah Messinger, and a dvar Torah from Lylah. Everyone is invited to the kiddush lunch upon conclusion of the services.
